In the event of a student arriving late for school they are required to sign-in at reception and have a note from home explaining why they are late, as we do appreciate that there are circumstances that are beyond control at times. The students' diary is stamped and the time is written in so the subject teacher can amend the attendance record on our management information system.

From January 06th 2020, the following will apply for students who present **without a note from home**:

LATE AM

On the THIRD AM LATE (Including late to assembly) the student will have a lunchtime detention from 1.35 - 1.55 pm.

Every subsequent late thereafter will result in a lunch time detention.

LATE PM

Any student who returns late to school after lunch must serve lunch time detention the following school day.

Failure to attend lunchtime detention will result in an afterschool detention.

We anticipate that this will not be an issue for the vast majority of students who are on time every morning and after lunch time.
