


# Leaving Certificate Applied

The Leaving Certificate Applied is <u>a two year</u> <u>Leaving Certificate</u> available to students who wish to follow a <u>practical programme</u> with a strong practical and vocational emphasis.


It is one of three Leaving Certificate options offered by the Department of Education and Skills



### <u>What is different about the Leaving</u> <u>Certificate Applied?</u>

- It is a distinct, self-contained two-year Leaving Certificate programme aimed at preparing students for adult and <u>working life.</u> Work experience is a significant component and students get to sample a range of jobs.
- The learning experiences are <u>active and practical.</u>
- Less emphasis on final exams as course work is assessed throughout the two years.
- Students work and skill development is <u>assessed in</u> <u>different ways</u> including interviews, practical, oral and written.
- <u>**Regular feedback**</u> on success and achievement with four statements of result during the two years.


## Leaving Certificate Applied Qualification

 60-69 % (120 - 139 credits)

 Merit
 70-84 % (140 - 169 credits)

 Distinction
 85-100 % (170 - 200 credits)
