- 2. It is strictly forbidden to smoke, vape, abuse alcohol and use drugs while on mobilities or while hosting.
- 3. It is not allowed to drive any motorized vehicle.
- 4. Behavior must be responsible.
- 5. Attend class punctually and follow the established schedule.
- 6. Students attend class with corresponding/required school materials.
- 7. Students will interact with the teaching team/accompanying staff/other students/host families etc. responsibly.
- 8. Students must adapt to the standards/rules of school while on mobility.
- 9. Photos and work completed will be used as evidence of Erasmus mobilities and for dissemination of information about Erasmus+.
